Prepare inside cover page with ISBN, copyright info & credits.

File for copyright. www.copyright.gov

Set up registration with publishing company. (i.e. **Ingram Spark**)

Load files. Choose desired publishing date and presale date.

You've got a finished book! Now prepare your website, advertising materials, promotional bookmarks, stickers, pins, business cards, and swag!
